Braunschweig Testimony of Czech Historiography of the 13th Century

The study deals with the chronicle collection entitled *Cronica Boemorum auct. Canonico S. Blasii Brunsvicensis*, which originated between 1292 and 1296, and the relationship of this work to narrative sources of Czech provenance of the 13th and 14th centuries. The compiler of this work, the canon of the chapter of St Blase in Braunschweig, used the chronicle of Cosmas and the works of his two continuators, whose narration he significantly reduced, but his work still contains certain passages and details over and above these models. The study attempts to prove that this shows the existence of an unpreserved original detailed version of the Second Continuation of Cosmas.

Slavonice Deperdita. Indulgences for the Chapel of Corpus Christi near Slavonice

The study deals with documents – now lost – from the period before 1306, which are related to Slavonice. First, a group of indulgences for the Chapel of Corpus Christi near Slavonice from the 1290s is discussed. These documents were discovered at the beginning of the 18th century and subsequently captured in a number of copies, following which the originals were once again lost. The second part deals with a document of the Templar commander Ekko, which has only an indirect connection with Slavonice, since it was only issued there. In 1819 Josef Edmund Horký found this document in Třebíč in the binding of a book of accounts and arranged for a copy to be made of it. Shortly afterwards in 1822, the original document was evidently destroyed in the fire at Třebíč. Based on Horký's copy, a number of other copies and editions were created, the relationships between which is also the subject of the present study.

The Parcelling out of Manor Lands on the Hukvaldy Estate at the Turn of the 18th and 19th Centuries

At the end of the 18th century, an important process took place across a number of estates in the Czech Lands, known in historiography as parcelling. This was the dividing up of aristocratic agricultural land into larger or smaller plots, which were sold to interested parties for use in the form of domainal tenure. Such a process took place on the Hukvaldy estate, which belonged to the private nobility - the Archbishop of Olomouc. The article discusses the motives, goals and course of parcelling on this estate. In some cases, new settlements were created through parcelling, in some only large agricultural estates, the so-called landjunkerei.

Cholera on the Move. The First Cholera Epidemic in the Czech Lands 1831–1838

The study traces the origin and progress of cholera on the European continent. This completely new disease broke out on the European continent for the first time in the 1830s and caused a major epidemic that swept across Europe and escalated into a pandemic. The author focuses on its spread through the territory of the Habsburg Monarchy and provides data on how many victims it left in its wake, especially in the Czech Lands. The author is also interested in the anti-cholera measures implemented by the Austrian authorities and the results of these. Experience with combatting the epidemic led to the gradual suppression of the disease until its complete eradication thanks to the discoveries of the German epidemiologist Robert Koch.

Participation of the Local Population in the Planning of the Nové Mlýny Dam Network. The Example of the Flooded Municipality of Mušov

The study deals with the planning of the Nové Mlýny waterworks under late socialism. It looks at the whole process from the perspective of the population, which bore the brunt of the changes, using the example of the village of Mušov, which disappeared as a result of the project. The aim of the study is to analyze the role of the population of Mušov in the process of building the Nové Mlýny waterworks and to put it in the context of the activities of the central and local government authorities. The paper focuses on the negotiation strategies and participation mechanisms of the population in these debates, the rules of which were based on the specifics of functioning of the authoritarian communist regime and the functioning of the hydro-social configuration of modernity. Archive research has revealed that the inhabitants of Mušov tried to resist constant economic and social pressure in the reform year of 1968, when they developed activities to draw attention to the planned demise of the village. After the failure of their public activities, they began to focus on building so-called Nový Mušov and on an economic settlement with the government of Czechoslovakia.

Forgotten Are They, Whose Name Is Forgotten. Štěpánka Mikešová, Jewish Victim from Lidice

Being informed on became one of the phenomena of everyday life in the Protectorate of Bohemia and Moravia. As a result, thousands of people were murdered, having been denounced for their racial origin, resistance activities, listening to foreign radio stations, and so on. Three examples of denunciations and evaluations of contemporary sources point to the danger of the deliberate discrediting of evidence, which may be reflected in the relativization of racial persecution and of the participation of the domestic population in its implementation.
